## SCHOOL LEAVING/VALEDICTORY CERTIFICATE CRITERIA

- 1. Student must have at least a ninety percent (90%) attendance record to school and classes.
- **2.** Student must attend all classes punctually, unless there is a valid reason for lateness or absence.
- 3. Student must be an active member of a school club or society.
- **4.** Student's deportment and attitude must reflect the standard set by the school.
- **5.** Student must be entered for a minimum of five subjects in external examinations (CSEC, GCE, City & Guilds).
- **6.** Student must sit all internal examinations unless an acceptable, written excuse is given.
- **7.** Student must complete SBAs for all external examinations for which they have been entered.
- **8.** Student must be fully prepared for all classes, i.e. with textbook, pen, pencil, calculators etc.
- **9.** Attendance at form time is compulsory.
- **10**. Attendance at General Assembly, Year Group Assembly and House Meetings is compulsory.
